
Thank you for last year's positive response to the parish appeal, which helped to stabilise our financial situation. However, we have more work to do to ensure the parish becomes sustainable into the future.

Use of parish collections

First collection – donations support the Society of Christ in Australia. Father's personal needs are covered such as health insurance and travel expenses. Our current level of giving to the first collection is sufficient. *Thank you! Bóg zapłać!*

Second collection – donations go to the Parish account and pay for the daily operation of a contemporary parish, liturgical needs and ministries, maintenance of the church and facilities and its responsibility for the priest's food, housing and transport.

Budget target amount

\$200,000 is our target income for the next 12 months. We've been advised to plan for a 7% increase in costs due to Australia's current financial situation.

Many parishioners donate items and volunteer labour. Our parish administration is now in serious need of paid support to assist Father, especially as we begin major fundraising.

Regular planned giving is critical

Electronic banking in its various forms is the best way to support the parish budget. It costs less to administer and makes bookkeeping easier.

Cash amounts vary significantly from week to week, which makes it difficult to budget.

The bank also needs to see validated records of regular income sources and *substantial* savings in our account for us to be able to support a major loan for urgent repairs and maintenance.

This is why regular planned giving is vital to the future of our parish.


Capital Fundraising Campaign

To tackle our major repair and upgrade projects in an organised way, we are launching a major fundraising campaign called 'Keep the Blue Cross Shining'. The Archdiocese has granted us permission for a dedicated bank account to collect funds. Until mid-2024, every dollar will support the capital works project, and not be considered parish income. Donations and fundraising will be separate to our weekly giving.

With our mission for peace as the premier state memorial for Queensland Catholic sailors and soldiers who died in WWI, we aim to share the message of this campaign as widely as possible. In a sense, Our Lady of Victories parish belongs to all Queensland Catholics, and we could use their support to protect and renew this iconic landmark and site.
